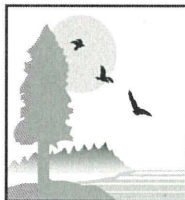

NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Title: CONSIDER APPLICATION FOR A PROSPECTING PERMIT FOR PRECIOUS METALS AND MINERALS OTHER THAN OIL, GAS, GEOTHERMAL RESOURCES, OR SAND AND GRAVEL - W 41000

Location: Approximately 640 acres of State fee-owned school land (State Parcel No. 244-009 and No. 244-010; Assessor's Parcel Number 042-050-018), located within Section 36, T14S, R20E, SBM, within the Cargo Muchachos Mountains, Imperial County.

Description: Authorize the issuance of a mineral prospecting permit for a 2-year term beginning August 1, 2019, following approval by the Commission and execution by both the State and Applicant, for precious metals and minerals other than oil, gas, geothermal resources, sand and gravel, within the State parcel.
