Project Title: Hodge / Keare Family Trust – Pier Modification Project
(Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0372-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Lake Tahoe, in the County of El Dorado, State of California; Latitude 39.226143, Longitude -120.072664; 5372 North Lake Boulevard, Carnelian Bay, CA.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0372-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to John Hodge.

The project proposes to reconstruct the pier head of the existing structure with a new design trending towards conformance, in addition to removal of the existing gantry, addition of a boat lift through conversion of one (1) recognized mooring buoy and modification of a 30-foot segment of the existing fixed catwalk to an adjustable height platform. The pier head is proposed to be reconfigured to eliminate the angled pier section with a conforming 'straightened' pier head. The new pier head will utilize primarily an open pile construction by way of nine (9) new 10.75" driven steel piles, yet will retain a section of the existing underlying rock and timber crib support to be repaired and reinforced.
