Project Location (include county): The project is located at 11 road crossing culverts between post miles 2.70 and 9.14, west of Red Bluff along highway 36 from the western boundary of the City of Red Bluff and heading west approximately 10 miles, County of Tehama.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0258-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to California Department of Transportation.

The proposed project would repair or replace eleven culvert locations at eleven locations along highway 36 between post mile 2.70 and 9.14.
