Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration

Environmental Assessment/Initial Study for Amendment to the Long-Term Renewal Contract Between the United States and Corning Water District Providing Project Water Service from the Sacramento River Division for the Purpose of Relinquishing a Portion of the Contract Total Available for Public Review and Comment

The Bureau of Reclamation and the Corning Water District have jointly prepared an Environmental Assessment (EA)/Initial Study (IS) and draft Negative Declaration (ND) on the effects of executing an Amendment to the Long-Term Renewal Contract between the United States and Corning Water District providing Project Water Service from the Sacramento River Diversion, for the purpose of relinquishing a portion of Corning Water District's Central Valley Project water supply to Reclamation to help meet its statutory obligation to provide a water supply to wildlife refuges in the Sacramento and San Joaquin Valleys. The water would no longer be available to Corning Water District, in Tehama County, and would be delivered to 19 Central Valley Project Improvement Act (CVPIA) refuges in the Sacramento and San Joaquin Valleys in Glenn, Colusa, Sutter, Stanislaus, Merced, Fresno, Tulare, and Kern counties.
