This agreement serves to implement the first agreement by allowing DWR to convey Ventura's water to the Agency, the Agency to schedule this water, and DWR to invoice the Agency for the water.</p> <p>The project approved by the Agency's Board of Directors entails the two agreements, the exchange of water contemplated by the agreements, and any future agreement or approval necessary from DWR or any other entity for the water exchange contemplated in the Water Exchange Agreements to take place (collectively, the "Project")</p>
