DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Grant a five-year renewal of a Special Events Permit to the Transcendence Theater Company to stage performances in the Old Winery Ruins area at Jack London State Historic Park. The Permit would allow up to four (4) annual theatrical productions (up to 30 performances in total), with up to 860 attendees at each performance.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of permitting of existing public or private facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond current levels; minor alterations in land use limitations with an average slope of less than 20%, which do not result in any changes in land use or density; and construction or placement of minor structures appurtenant to existing facilities and is included as "Issuance or easements and permits" and "installation of signs, placement of portable toilets", in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities in accordance with CCR § 15300.4.
