Description Continuation:

Current: Caltrans maintenance crews have assessed the current condition and vulnerability of the following culverts located between PM 17.36 and 19.98 to future debris flows ahead of the upcoming rainy season. The crews have determined this additional maintenance is necessary to keep SR154 open and protected from the debris clogging culverts at these locations:

- SB-154-17.36: Remove excess woody material from event and regrade overflow channel area. Clear Inlet of culvert of debris, replace right-of-way fencing destroyed from emergency event. Add debris rack.
- SB-154-18.94: Remove woody material from debris flow. Clear Inlet of culvert of debris.
- SB-154-19.17: Clear Inlet of culvert of debris. Regrade to drain.
- SB-154-19.21: Clear Inlet of culvert of debris. Regrade to drain.
- SB-154-19.98: 24" Culvert. Clear inlet of culvert of debris. Regrade to drain.

Most of the cleanup is within Caltrans R/W, however, we are obtaining a total of 4 emergency ROE for access to private property.
