PROJECT TITLE: Statewide Emergency Cache – Sugar Pine

LOCATION: Ed Z'berg Sugar Pine Point State Park **COUNTY:** El Dorado

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install one (1) prewired 8' wide x 20' long x 8'-6" high cargo container at Ed Z'berg Sugar Pine Point State Park to facilitate the storage of supplies necessary for the emergency evacuation of museum collections in the event of a disaster. The cargo container will be installed at the southern end of a row of similar containers, west of the Maintenance Garage. Work will:

- Remove the trailer currently stored at the selected location;
- Remove pine needles and duff from the location and grade to level;
- If needed, excavate a 75' long by 18" deep trench for electrical conduit, install electrical infrastructure, backfill the trench with excavated dirt and repave;
- Place cargo container on prepared site; and
- Hook up the electrical (or solar power) to the cargo container.


