Thank you for contacting the San Manuel Band of Mission Indians (SMBMI) regarding the above referenced project. SMBMI appreciates the opportunity to review the project documentation, which was received by our Cultural Resources Management Department on 13 June 2019, pursuant to CEQA (as amended, 2015) and CA PRC 21080.3.1. The proposed project area exists within Serrano ancestral territory and, therefore, SMBMI elects to consult on this project. For your knowledge, the project area lies between two pre-contact Serrano villages – Jurupet, which was in the area of the La Loma Hills, and Junubabit, which was in the area of the 10/215 interchange. Additionally, the Santa Ana River itself is an important resource to the SMBMI community, as it provides habitat for important plants and animals. As such, due to the nature and location of the proposed project, SMBMI respectfully requests the cultural resources report for review upon availability, as well the following documents, if required for the project:

- Biology report
- Geotechnical report
- Project plans showing the vertical extent of proposed disturbance

The provision of this information will assist San Manuel Band of Mission Indians during under CEQA and how they participate, moving forward, in project review and implementation. If you should have any questions with regard to this matter, please do not hesitate to contact me at your convenience, as I will be your Point of Contact (POC) for SMBMI with respect to this project.
