Project Title: Laurelwood Data Center		
Project Location: The portion of the project located at 2201 Laurelwood Road in Santa Clara, California along Valley Water fee title property and easement is adjacent to San Tomas Aquino Creek and lies between a privately-owned parcel (APN 104-40-021) and Valley Water-owned parcel (APN 104-40-032).		
Project Description: Silicon Valley Power (SVP) is proposing to install one approximately 206-foot-long 60kV transmission line, consisting of a total of six electrical cables, across a portion of San Tomas Aquino Creek. The line would be connected to power utility poles constructed outside of Valley Water property. As part of the Laurelwood project, the project is seeking an Encroachment Permit and Aerial Easement from Valley Water to install one 60 kilovolt transmission line.		

The lead agency (California Energy Commission) adopted the Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration and filed a Notice of Determination for the Laurelwood Data Center project on February 5, 2020.

This is to advise that Valley Water, as a responsible agency, has considered the MND as prepared by the Commission and has approved the above-described project on September 24, 2024. Valley Water has made the following determinations regarding the project:


