Project Description:

Create fuel management zone (FMZ) 23 (16 acres) and FMZ 24 (38 acres) surrounding Canyon Acres Drive and Laguna Canyon Road in Laguna Beach. Goat-grazing and hand crews would reduce or clear vegetation load in 100-foot wide sections to reduce the risk of wildfire threat to existing structures. The majority of perennial root systems would remain to minimize erosion in erosion-prone areas.
