Project Title: Operation of Antelope Creek Diversions (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0693-R1

Project Location (include county): The project is located at the Edwards Dam on Antelope Creek, tributary to the Sacramento River, in the County of Tehama, State of California; Latitude 401004.03, Longitude 1220939.35; APN # 049-150-001; 049-150-002.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0693-R1, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicants, Jim Edwards and Los Molinos Mutual Water Company.

The project is limited to operation, inspection, maintenance, and repair of water diversion facilities on Antelope Creek and maintenance of the New Creek Apron adjacent to the diversion facilities.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on August 28, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW’s approval of the project.
