**Project Location (Sonoma):** The Sonoma 1 Culvert Rehabilitation Project (Project) is located along State route (SR) 1 in Sonoma County, California from Post Mile (PM) 30.8 to PM 40.6 between Mill Gulch and 0.5 mile south of Miller Creek.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-SON-25567-R3) pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the Project Applicant, Lindsay Vivian, California Department of Transportation.

The Project is limited to replacing 13 culverts. These culverts are located at Post Mile (PM) 30.81, 31.12, 31.26, 31.44,31.49, 35.34, 36.53, 38.12, 39.30, 39.98, 40.00, 40.33, and 40.57.
