**Project Title:** Caselman South Subdivision (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-25730-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at Beacon Creek in the Vineyard community of unincorporated Sacramento County, State of California; Latitude 38.474333, Longitude -121.387902; Assessor's Parcel Number 115-0091-057-0000. The project is generally located at 8680 Caselman Road in Sacramento, CA 95828.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-25730-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Hari Johl.

The project is limited to installation of a detention basin outfall as a part of the development of a residential subdivision. The detention basin outfall improvements include installation of a 36-inch diameter reinforced concrete pipe (or high-density polyethylene pipe) within a 3-foot, 10-inch concrete headwall per Sacramento County Standard Drawing 9-26H and trash rack per Sacramento County Standard Drawing 9-26G. A 70-foot-long concrete overflow weir will be constructed in upland areas to connect the outfall with a newly constructed detention basin. The drainage outfall improvements will be constructed in an existing concreted portion of Beacon Creek and will occur during summer-fall months when there is no water in Beacon Creek.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement for the project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan  was /  was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
