**Project Title:** Marsh Drive Bridge over Walnut Creek Replacement (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0029-R3)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located on Marsh Drive approximately 0.2 miles west of Solano Way in the City of Concord and unincorporated Pacheco, in the County of Contra Costa, State of California; Latitude 37.99889, Longitude -122.0561; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 125-210-004, 159-140-056, 159-140-055, 125-210-012, 125-210-011 and 125-010-023.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0029-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, East Bay Regional Park District.

The project consists of the construction of a new bridge over Walnut Creek and the removal of the existing bridge.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above, described project on May 21, 2021 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
