Project Title: Elder Creek Channel Improvement Project (California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-2020-016-06 Minor Amendment No. 1 (ITP))

Project Location (include county): The Project is located along approximately 2,100 linear feet of Elder Creek within the City of Highland, in San Bernardino County. The Project is located from Old Greenspot Road to just southwest of the confluence of Elder Creek and Church Street Channel, approximately 700 feet downstream of Abbey Way.

Project Description: This proposed project involves a minor amendment to Conditions of Approval 9 and 10 in the original ITP to allow the Permittee 18 months after the onset of project construction, rather than 18 months from the effective date of the original ITP, to complete the compensatory mitigation requirement.

The amendment to the original ITP will not increase the impacts or mitigation as stated in the original ITP.
