Project Title: Issuance of Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0684-R1, Bridge and Vegetation Maintenance on Hayfork Creek

Project Location (include county): The project is located at Hayfork Creek, a tributary to South Fork Trinity River in the County of Trinity, State of California; Section 08, Township 31N, Range 11W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Hayfork Summit quadrangle, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian; Latitude 40.55631N, Longitude 123.12465W; Assessor's Parcel Number 017-380-15-00.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0684-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Kristi Swift.

This project consists of the replacement of a failing retaining wall in the northwest quadrant of an existing bridge over Hayfork Creek, and the continued maintenance of riparian vegetation immediately under and surrounding the bridge which serves as the primary access to Permittee's parcel.
