LOCATION: Sugarloaf Ridge State Park

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Add a hot/cold water dispenser to the Visitor Center at Sugarloaf Ridge State Park to provide visitors and volunteers with a hot/cold filtered water source. Work will:

- Drill a 2" diameter hole in the floor of the visitor center,
- Run a potable water hose from an existing outside hose bib to, and up through, the hole;
- Attach a hot/cold potable water splitter to the hose;
- Install the new water dispenser in the visitor center; and
- Connect the potable water hose to the water dispenser.
