The proposed project involves the demolition of Building D, an approximately 26,952 net square-foot two-story underutilized and inadequately programmed science building at Malibu Middle High School (MMHS). The removal of Building D would allow for the expansion of the student quad area. While the project would occur alongside additional campus improvements, the proposed project would not result in the expansion of existing school capacity or impact any sensitive resources on the project site; therefore, the project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 and Section 15303. The proposed project was also reviewed for possible exceptions under Section 15300.2 and found that the exceptions do not apply.
