Project Location: The project is located at the Yuba River, in the County Yuba, State of California; Section 21, Township 16N, Range 6E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map. Assessor's Parcel Number 005-550-003.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0128-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Thomas R. McCay.

The project is limited to the placement of a 200 linear foot road/trail down the embankment, for access to the Yuba River. The road/trail will be cleared of vegetation (scrub and brush) and graded with a Cat D 6 C.
