Title: Upper Long Bar Salmonid Habitat Restoration Project

Applicant: South Yuba River Citizens League

Location: Sovereign land in the Yuba River channel and floodplain, adjacent to Assessor's Parcel Numbers 006-170-065, -119, -122, -139, -143, -144, near Marysville, Yuba County

Description: The Project involves the removal of approximately 82,207 cubic yards (CY) and fill of approximately 90 CY of earth material to create a variety of salmonid habitat features including alcoves, enhanced flood runner, and edge habitat enhancement areas. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 5-year General Lease – Other through April 2, 2030.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on April 2, 2025, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB), certified the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program and approved the project on September 12, 2022. The California State Lands Commission has considered the EIR as prepared for this project by the SWRCB and adopted an independent Mitigation Monitoring Program incorporating SWRCB's document.
