Project Title: Nassau Creek (West Branch Cherokee Creek) Bridge Replacement Project (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. CAL-24294-R2)

Project Location (include county): The Project is located at Nassau Creek and its tributary, on State Route 4, in the County of Calaveras, State of California. The post miles (PM) for this Project are CAL-4 PM 15.9 to 16.3.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number CAL-24294-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.

The Project includes the construction of a new Nassau Creek bridge at a new location, the demolition of the current Nassau Creek bridge, the realignment of a segment of State Route 4, and a culvert replacement. The Project is limited to vegetation clearing and grubbing, tree removal, placement of fill on the banks and streambed, grading of the banks, concrete pouring, dewatering, and bridge demolition.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the Project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this Project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this Project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this Project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
