Project Title: Marin Country Club – Arroyo San Jose Site 4B Cart Path and Bank Stabilization (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0159-R3)

Project Location: The project is located on the Marin Country Club at 500 Country Club Drive, Novato, CA 94949 in the County of Marin.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0159-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Marin Country Club, as represented by Kevin Pryseski.

The project involves bank stabilization along Arroyo San Jose and relocation of a golf cart path and associated infrastructure along the right bank of the creek.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on September 11, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
