Thank you for including the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in the review process for the above referenced ND. The proposed project involves the implementation of the following elements to control and/or limit existing soil, soil vapor, and semi-perched aquifer contamination at the site:

- land use controls;
- containment;
- soil vapor extraction (SVE);
- hydraulic property boundary containment;
- on-site enhanced reductive dechlorination (ERD)/in-situ chemical oxidation (ISCO) recirculation;
- off-site groundwater extraction (GWE); and
- monitored natural attenuation (MNA).

The Lead Agency is the Department of Toxic Substances Control under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

The project is located approximately 2,000 feet away from Interstate 405 in the City of Inglewood. After reviewing the ND, Caltrans does not expect project approval to result in a direct adverse impact to the existing State transportation facilities.
