Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0238-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Richard Wilbur Ranch represented by Richard Wilbur.

The project is limited to the contouring and rock armoring of approximately 480 linear feet of unstable and sloughing bank, along the south bank of the Yuba River. The unstable banks will be contoured on a 2:1 slope, rock armor will be placed above the ordinary high-water mark of the bank.
