PROJECT TITLE: Recycled Water Pipeline on Village of Heritage (Project)

PROJECT LOCATION: The project site is located along a public street (West Grand Avenue & East Grand Avenue) and will pass through two parkways that lie between the two meandering streets. The streets are in the public right-of-way and the parkways are owned and maintained by the City of Fontana.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program is financing the Project. The project will construct approximately 2,100 feet of twelve-inch recycled water pipeline along East Grand Avenue between South Heritage Circle and Cabrillo Court.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has approved SRF financing for the Project described above on April 7, 2022 and determined that the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act. The Cucamonga Valley Water District will be carrying out the Project.

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION STATUS:

Class 3: New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures

(California Code of Regulations, title 14, division 6, chapter 3, article 19, section 15303)

REASON WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: The Project has been determined to meet the requirements of the exemptions selected above and will not have a significant impact on water quality. The Project involves the installation of a new, recycled water pipeline which does not exceed one mile in length.
