Project Title: Two Bar Road PM 1.13 Storm Damage Repair Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0264-R3)

Project Location: The project is located at Two Bar Creek a tributary to the San Lorenzo River, in the County of Santa Cruz, State of California; Latitude 37.155046, Longitude -122.122064 or Section 18, Township 9N, Range 2W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Felton.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0264-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the County of Santa Cruz Department of Public Works.

In February 2017, heavy rains saturated the soil downslope of Two Bar Road which caused the embankment, trees, and a portion of the road to erode downslope towards Two Bar Creek. The proposed project will make repairs to the embankment and road.
