**Project Title:** CHP Academy Drainage Channel Improvements Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0316-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at a drainage channel (Channel CH2) within the West Sacramento California Highway Patrol (CHP) Academy, in the County of Yolo, State of California; Latitude 38.5957083, Longitude -121.5581749, Section 29, Township 9N, Range 4E of the Mt. Diablo Meridian, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5 minute quadrangle map West Sacramento.


**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0316-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Highway Patrol, as represented by Travis Thrasher.

The project is limited to improvements to a man-made drainage channel (Channel CH2) and the installation of ditches, erosion control, concrete V-gutters, a trench drain, and the replacement of a pedestrian foot bridge.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 6/18/2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
