**Project Title:** Butte 70 Corridor Improvement Project, Segment 3 EA 03-3H930 (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0219-R2) Amendment 1

**Project Location (include county):** The Project is located at post miles YUB 25.5/25.8 and BUT 0.0/4.0, at North Honcut Creek, Drainage flowing to North Honcut Creek, South Honcut Creek, and Wilson Creek in the County of Yuba and the County of Butte, California.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has issued Amendment #1 to Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification Number 1600-2020-0219-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.

Amendment #1 changes the Project Description and Project Impacts to include the construction of a retaining/stabilization structure on the bank of North Honcut Creek and additional permanent riparian impacts resulting from Project activities. In addition, the mitigation requirement was increased to account for the increased permanent riparian impacts.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement Amendment on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the Project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this Project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the Project.
