**Project Title:** Wildcat Creek Restoration and Greenway Trail (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0255-R3)

**Project Location:** The project is located at Wildcat Creek, in the City of San Pablo between Vale Road (upstream) and Church Lane (downstream), in the County of Contra Costa, State of California; Latitude 37.954879, Longitude -122.339695; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 417-310-006 and 417-310-007.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0255-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to City of San Pablo.

The project will recontour and restore the right bank of Wildcat creek to improve sediment transport and wildlife habitat, construct a greenway trail, and reconfigure an existing parking lot.
