Dear Ms. Hauptman:

Thank you for including the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in the environmental review process for the above referenced project. LADWP proposes to implement the proposed project to fill in approximately 2,150 feet of the Haynes Intake Channel with engineered fill, creating approximately 8 acres of vacant land. The proposed project would occur over two phases. The duration of Phase I construction activities would be approximately 15 months, with proposed construction scheduled to begin in late 2021 and end in 2023. The duration of Phase II construction activities would be approximately 30 months, beginning in 2030 and ending in 2032.

After reviewing the revised MND, Caltrans does not expect project approval to result in a direct adverse impact to the existing State transportation facilities.

Transportation of heavy construction equipment and/or materials, which requires the use of oversized-transport vehicles on State highways, will require a transportation permit from Caltrans when transporting disposed materials. It is recommended that large size truck trips be limited to off-peak commute periods.
