Hello Stacy and Gavin,

Thank you for your letter, for DTSC's interest in the subject project, and for reviewing the MND! The summary below aims at addressing the six items DTSC made recommendations on:

1. The Geology/Soils/Seismic/Topography section (page 39) discusses a Hazardous Materials Prevention and Response Plan to be prepared to allow for a prompt and effective response to any accidental spills, should they occur.
2. No sites within the project area have been used or are suspected of having been used for mining activities.
3. The recommended effort (for ADL) has already been conducted and is discussed in the MND (pages 44-45)
4. No building or structures will be demolished as a result of the proposed project. Regardless, Measure AQ-16 in the Air Quality section of the MND (page 49) discusses asbestos.
5. Measure Bio-13 (page 64) discusses clean imported fill.
6. The project site has not been used for agricultural or weed abatement activities.

Hopefully this follow-up sufficiently addresses DTSC's inquiries. At this point, I do not see a need to incorporate new information related to DTSC's recommendations in the MND.
