**Project Title:** 2017 Fire Damage Tomki Road Culverts MP 0.65 0.69 (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0694-R1)

**Project Location:** The project is approximately 3.75 miles north of the town of Redwood Valley, at milepost 0.65 and 0.69 on Tomki Road, in the County of Mendocino, State of California; Section 20, Township 17N, Range 12W; Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, in the Redwood Valley, Calif. U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle. Latitude 39.320453°, Longitude -123.223604°, and 39.321032°, -123.223972°.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0694-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Howard Dashiell, representing Mendocino County Department of Transportation.

The project replaces two culverts with culverts sized to accommodate 100-year flows and associated debris and sediment. The culverts will be installed to current standards, and construction will minimize impacts to natural resources. At milepost 0.69, a culvert with a minimum 24-inch diameter and 60-foot length will be installed. At milepost 0.65, a culvert with a minimum 24-inch diameter and 36-foot length will be installed.
