Project Title: State Route (SR) 12 Capital Preventive Maintenance Project

Project Applicant: California Department of Transportation, District 4

Project Location (include county): SR12 in Sonoma County from Post Mile (PM) 30.8 to 40.6

Project Description:

The Project proposes to resurface the existing pavement on SR 12, including the shoulders, between Llano Road (PM 11.0) and Farmers Lane (PM 17.4) from the outskirts of the City of Sebastopol to the City of Santa Rosa in Sonoma County. Additional work includes upgrading four curb ramps to meet American with Disabilities Act standards, replacing up to 38 existing concrete approach slabs with 1.25-foot-thick new slabs, reconstructing drainage infrastructure, and upgrading up to 10,000 linear feet of the existing metal beam guardrail to Midwest Guardrail System. Along the eastbound SR 12 to southbound U.S. Highway 101 connector, a 300-linear-foot drainage system would be reconstructed on the outside shoulder from the end of the existing retaining wall to the existing sound wall. All work proposed would be within the Caltrans right of way.
