OC Waste & Recycling is proposing to construct and operate a 204 ton per day green waste composting operation called the Capistrano Greenery at the active Prima Deshecha Landfill, which is located at 32250 Avenida La Pata, San Juan Capistrano. The composting operation will be located on a 18 acre area of the landfill that is completely disturbed. The proposed composting operation will allow the County and incorporated cities to divert green waste materials from landfill disposal, and recycle these materials, in compliance with recent State mandates.

Please identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

The proposed Capistrano Greenery composting operation is located on a completely disturbed area and will therefore not result in any direct impacts to biological resources. However, the project site is located near existing habitat and could therefore result in indirect noise impacts to nesting birds, which includes the burrowing owl. OC Waste & Recycling has incorporated mitigation measures into the project to ensure that the proposed composting operation will not result in any significant impacts to nesting birds including the burrowing owl. The Mitigated Negative Declaration/Initial Study did not identify any other significant environmental impacts associated with the project.
