**Project Title:** Sack Dam Routine Maintenance (Project) (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0022-R4)

**Project Location:** The Project will occur at Sack Dam within and adjacent to the San Joaquin River at the confluence of the Arroyo Canal, approximately 7 miles southeast of the City of Dos Palos, on the boarder of Fresno and Madera Counties, California, Assessor's Parcel Numbers: Fresno County: 001-210-03 and Madera County: 022-090-001,035-030-017 and 035-030-018, Township 11 South, Range 13 East; Section 12, USGS 7.5 Minute Quad Map Poso Farm, MDB & M, Latitude 36.983592, Longitude -120.500178.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0022-R4, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Henry Miller Reclamation District #2131.

The Project includes activities related to the routine maintenance of the existing Sack Dam including the placement of material along the access road/berm and the removal of debris and obstructions along Sack Dam.
