**Project Location (include county):** The project is located on State Route (SR) 49 where it crosses the North Fork Mokelumne River, between highway post miles (PM) 0.0 to 0.5 in Amador County and PM 30.4 and 30.9 in Calaveras County; Latitude 38.31264, Longitude -120.72036; Section1, Township 9N, Range 11E of the Mt. Diablo Meridian, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute quadrangle map Mokelumne Hill.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-AMA-18838-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.

The project is limited to widening and replacing bridge rails and shoulder overhang to include four-foot shoulders. Overall bridge width will increase by four feet. Existing roadway approach shoulders will also be widened to four feet for approximately 50 linear feet, on each side, to match the bridge width. The project is also limited to the installation of temporary work pads below the bridge, the removal and replacement of an East Bay Municipal Utilities District water monitoring station, and the installation of angular rock slope protection in an unvegetated area under the north bridge abutment to discourage illegal camping.
