**Project Title:** Mokelumne River Bridge Rail Upgrade Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. AMA-18838-R2) Amendment #1

**Project Location:** The project is located on State Route (SR) 49 where it crosses the North Fork Mokelumne River, between highway post miles (PM) 0.0 to 0.5 in Amador County and PM 30.4 and 30.9 in Calaveras County; Latitude 38.31264, Longitude -120.72036; Section 1, Township 9N, Range 11E of the Mt. Diablo Meridian, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute quadrangle map Mokelumne Hill.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Amendment #1 to the Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number AMA-18838-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.

Amendment #1 adds additional avoidance and minimization measures to protect fish and wildlife resources and includes additional compensatory mitigation and reporting measures.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the amendment to the above-described Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the revalidated negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
