**Project Title:** Londer Navarro River diversion of onstream Reservoir Diversion (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MEN-14092-R1)

**Project Location (include county):** The project to be completed is located within The project is located within the Navarro River watershed, approximately 3.6 miles Northwest of the town of Philo, County of Mendocino, State of California; Section 3, T14 North, R15 West, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, in the Philo U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 025-510-26 and 025-510-28; latitude 39.0959 and longitude - 123.4971 at the Navarro River point of diversion.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-MEN-14092-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Vivian Stapp, Jackson Family Wines.

The project is limited to 2 encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from the Navarro River to an onstream reservoir. One encroachment is for water diversion from an unnamed tributary to the Navarro River to an onstream reservoir. Water is diverted for frost protection and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. Water is diverted to storage for frost protection and irrigation under State Water Resource Control Board, Division of Water Rights Permit 20563. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the existing water diversion infrastructure.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
