Project Title: Cloverdale High School Stadium Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0109-R3)

Project Location: The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Cloverdale Creek at 509 North Cloverdale Boulevard, Cloverdale, in the County of Sonoma.


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0109-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Cloverdale Unified Union School District.

The project includes the replacement of an existing dirt track and grass field with a new synthetic track and turf field as part of a larger stadium project. The project is limited to surface water draining from the new track and field to discharge to a bioretention area and then out a storm drain into an unnamed tributary to Cloverdale Creek.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on August 26, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
