**Project Title:** Ontario Road Restoration Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0157-R4)

**Project Location:** The Project is located within and adjacent to the unnamed tributary to San Luis Obispo Creek located at 6900 Ontario Road, Avila Beach, California 93424, approximately 2 miles northeast of Avila Beach, San Luis Obispo County, State of California; Township 31 South, Range 12 East, Section 32, United States Geological Survey (USGS) map Pismo Beach, MDB&M; 35.18647,-120.70385; Assessor's Parcel Number 076-261-028 and 076-261-036.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0157-R4, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to King Ventures.

The Project is limited to the restoration of streams due to impacts created by the unauthorized removal of riparian vegetation, grading activities, installation of gravel, woodchips, silt fencing, and electrical box, and the dewatering of a pond within and adjacent to an unnamed tributary to San Luis Obispo Creek.



No significant environmental impacts will result if the Project is completed under the protective features included in Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0157-R4.
