Project Title: State Route 41 Ranchos Rehabilitation Project (California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-2021-008-04 (ITP)).

Project Location: The Project involves improvements to a 2.9-mile segment of SR 41, between post mile 6.3 and post mile 9.2 in Madera County.

Project Description: Within the 2.9-mile long Project Area, the Project will involve widening and elevating the State Route 41 roadway between post mile 6.5 and post mile 9.0 to correct non-standard shoulder widths, flooding potential, and line of sight issues. Beyond these points and within the 2.9-mile Project Area, the Project will involve repaving the existing roadway.

The Project could result in take of California tiger salamander (*Ambystoma californiense*) including mortality ("kill"), due to vehicle strikes, destruction of burrows, or temporary disturbance to habitat resulting in the loss of individuals over the three-year term of the ITP. California tiger salamander is listed as threatened under the California Endangered Species Act. Permittee will mitigate through permanent protection and long-term management of 38.3 acres of compensatory habitat for the Covered Species, OR the purchase of 38.3 Covered Species credits from a CDFW-approved mitigation or conservation bank.
