**Project Title:** Dockweiler Residential Development Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0071-R5)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Newhall Creek, on the southwest corner of the intersection of Dockweiler Drive and the Sierra Highway, in the county of Los Angeles; and can be located using the following: Latitude 34.371656, Longitude -118.502531; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 2833-018-022 and 2833-018-017.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0071-R5, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Dockweiler 21, LLC. The project consists of the construction of a 96-lot single-family private residential development complex. The proposed project would also provide a public multipurpose trail adjacent to Sierra Highway. The project will also construct a new miscellaneous transfer drain (MTD) to extend existing MTD 1525 to the east through the project.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on \_\_\_/\_\_\_/\_\_\_ and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
