Project Title: Eastlake Sanitary Landfill Expansion (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. LAK-40671-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Molesworth Creek, in the County of Lake, State of California; Latitude 38.95243, Longitude -122.60132 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); 16015 Davis Avenue, Clearlake CA 95422; Assessor's Parcel Numbers [APN] 010-053-110-000, 010-053-120-000, 010-053-130-000, 010-053-140-000, 010-008-030-000, 010-008-350-000, 010-008-390-000, 010-008-410-000, 041-224-400-000, 041-234-270-000, and 041-244-180-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number LAK-40671-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Lars Ewing.

The project is limited to the lateral expansion of the Eastlake Sanitary Landfill (ESL) which includes the construction of a stormwater detention basin and the restoration/enhancement of an intermittent stream channel and riparian corridor adjacent to the existing landfill. The existing landfill encompasses approximately 35 acres, and the expansion would add approximately 21.8 acres, increasing the total size of the ESL to 56.8 acres. Landfill expansion activities will take place over 4 phases with discrete cells or modules being constructed every 3 to 9 years.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

Notice of Determination

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The mitigated negative declaration prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of execution of the above Streambed Alteration Agreement as Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
