Project Title: Cloverdale Development (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0310-R3)

Project Location (include county): The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Icaria Creek and an unnamed roadside drainage that drains to the unnamed tributary, at 28195 Highway 101, Cloverdale, in the County of Sonoma.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0310-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Integrated Community Development.

The project is limited to the filling of approximately 1,300 square feet of an unnamed roadside drainage along the northern border of the project area as part of a larger residential development project. The project also includes the removal of a 30-foot-long and 30-inch-diameter corrugated metal pipe (CMP) culvert along an ephemeral creek on-site, and replacement with a 58-foot-long and 13-foot-wide precast open bottom culvert.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on May 12, 2021 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
