PROJECT TITLE: Fiber Conduit Installation Amendment

LOCATION: Indian Grinding Rock State Historic Park COUNTY: Amador

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install additional fiber conduit at Indian Grinding Rock to provide an improved and dependable communications system for the park office, visitor center and museum. This project is an amendment to Fiber Conduit Installation (SCH#: 2020020302) for additional work. Work will:

- Excavate a 20' L x 24" D x 12" W trench from the conduit box to the edge of the visitor center, excavated spoils will be used to back fill the trench;
- Install 2" fiber conduit in the new trench, along the edge of the visitor center in the currently existing French drain, and 5' above the trench into the space between the first and second floor of the visitor center;
- Run approximately 40' of fiber duct from the entry point of the exterior trench, to the furnace room; and
- Install a new fiber access point in the furnace room.
