NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

FILING OF NOTICE OF DETERMINATION IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 21152 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE

PROJECT TITLE: Rio Linda (RIO-3) High-Flow Diversion

CONTROL NUMBER: PLER2024-00038

PROJECT LOCATION: The project is located at the intersection of Elkhorn Boulevard and W 2nd Street, near the communities of Rio Linda and Linda Manor

APN: N/A – within the public roadway

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: Sacramento Area Sewer District (SacSewer) proposes to add the Rio Linda (RIO-3) High-Flow Diversion (RIO-3 Relief Project) to the previously approved Linda Manor Septic to Sewer Conversion Project (Septic to Sewer Project). The RIO-3 Relief Project includes the installation of an 8-inch, 63-foot-long overflow pipe connecting the existing RIO-3 sewer system to the proposed Linda Manor sewer system along W 2nd Street at the intersection with Elkhorn Boulevard. The pipe would be installed at the north end of the intersection extending 63 feet south along W 2nd Street. The addition of the overflow pipe would alleviate capacity constraints in the Rio Linda sewer system by diverting flows to the proposed Linda Manor sewer system. Additionally, the integration of the diversion pipe is anticipated to improve hydraulics in the Rio Linda sewer system and reduce the risk of sewer spills.

The RIO-3 Relief Project would be constructed at the same time as the Septic to Sewer Project minimizing impacts to the adjacent communities by removing the need for repetitive work in the intersection, decreasing the amount of traffic control, excavation, and pavement restoration. The RIO-3 Relief Project is within the boundaries of the previously analyzed Septic to Sewer Project.

This is to advise that the Sacramento Area Sewer District (Lead Agency) has approved the above described project on July 10, 2024 and has made the following determinations concerning the above described project.

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment.
2. An **Addendum to a previously adopted Mitigated Negative Declaration** was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. The **Linda Manor Septic to Sewer Conversion Project Mitigated Negative Declaration** sufficiently analyzes and addresses potential environmental impacts from the project, and the project will not trigger any of the criteria requiring additional CEQA review pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15162. The project will not result in new significant impacts or a substantial increase in the severity of the significant environmental impacts identified in the Linda Manor Septic to Sewer Conversion Project Mitigated Negative Declaration. The proposed project is within the scope of the Linda Manor Septic to Sewer Conversion Project Mitigated Negative Declaration consistent with CEQA Guidelines Section 15168(c)(2), as documented in the addendum.
4. Mitigation measures and standard project requirements from the Linda Manor Septic to Sewer Conversion Project **were** made a condition of the approval of the project; no new project-specific mitigation measures are required.
5. The implementation of applicable Linda Manor Septic to Sewer Conversion Project mitigation measures and standard project requirements will be monitored and reported pursuant to the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program that **was** adopted for this project.
6. A statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted for this project.
7. Findings **were not** made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA Guidelines 15091.
