

Station East Residential/Mixed Use Project CEQA Scoping Meeting CANCELLED Scoping Presentation Will Be Available Online Public Comments Due by April 9, 2020

Due to COVID-19 concerns, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Scoping Meeting for the Integral Project scheduled for Monday, March 23, 2020 has been **cancelled**. In lieu of the meeting, a recorded **Scoping Presentation** will be posted on the City's website. See information below.

Integral Communities, the project applicant, is proposing the Station East Residential/Mixed Use Project (project), an infill project involving the redevelopment of an approximately 26.5-acre site (project site) in the City of Union City, Alameda County, California. The project site is bound by Decoto Road to the north, 7th Street to the east, Bradford Way to the south, and the Union Pacific Railroad Niles Subdivision rail line to the west. As Lead Agency under the CEQA, the City of Union City has determined that the project may have a significant effect on the environment and that an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) will be prepared to evaluate these potential effects.
