## Notice of Completion of a Draft Tribal Environmental Impact Report

The Shingle Springs Band of Miwok Indians (Tribe) has prepared a Draft Tribal Environmental Impact Report (TEIR) to assess the potential off-reservation impacts of the Tribe's proposed entertainment center project (Project). The TEIR has been developed in accordance with the requirements of the Tribal-State Compact (Compact) between the Tribe and the State of California.

# **Project Description**

The Tribe is proposing to expand its Red Hawk Casino with the addition of an entertainment center. The 75,000-square-foot entertainment center would be developed above the northern half of the existing parking garage. The entertainment center would incorporate additional entertainment and dining options such as a bowling alley, virtual reality gaming suites, indoor go-karting, bar, and meeting rooms. In addition to the entertainment center, this TEIR addresses the expansion of the existing parking garage. The southern half of the existing eight-level parking garage would be expanded with an additional three levels. The additional three levels would expand the number of parking spaces from 3,040 to 3,600.

## **Project Location**

The Project is located on the Shingle Springs Rancheria within an unincorporated portion of El Dorado County approximately two miles northeast of the community of Shingle Springs. The proposed facilities would expand the Tribe's existing Red Hawk Casino, which is located on Red Hawk Parkway off Highway 50.
