A Site Approval application for truck and trailer parking facility, on a 2.3 acre parcel over two (2) Phases. Phase 1 will be unmanned and includes utilizing the existing paved area for the parking of ten (10) trucks and nine (9) trailers. Phase 2 includes additional surfacing for up to ten (10) additional trucks and up to nine (9) additional trailers. In addition, Phase 2 proposes to convert an existing 1,445 square foot house to an office. The parcel will be served by an existing septic system and existing on-site retention pond, and proposes to connect to public water.
